Today

In February 2020, in Dublin, it was agreed to establish a central body called *EuroLat* to represent the European lattice community.

Since then, the European landscape has changed drastically:

EuroHPC JU was created, and *PRACE* evolved.

Despite being one of the major users of HPC, the lattice QCD community has no direct representation to influence governing institutions:

No dedicated center of excellence

Growing interest in AI with significant representation.

Beyond direct funding calls, the community could benefit from:

- Common strategies for sharing data and software,
- Coordinated engagement with HPC centers,
- Addressing training needs and user support.

Further objectives will be identified during today's discussions.

Similar institutions exist in other countries, like USQCD
